

Safety: Zanzibar is generally safe, but it's wise to take standard precautions like safeguarding valuables and using reputable tour operators like JM TAXI AND TOURS.

Secure Your Belongings: Use a money belt or theft-protected bag when exploring towns, and avoid leaving valuables unattended on the beach



Seasonal Planning: Consider the seasons before planning your trip, as Zanzibar experiences different weather patterns throughout the year.

Light Clothing: Pack light clothes but remember to include long sleeves and trousers/skirts for protection from the sun and to adhere to dress codes.
